HOW TO GET AROUND

**RIVER WALK**—The River Walk runs parallel to the City Center's main thoroughfare and the trolley route. It's a 4-mile, paved trail extending from the Port of Astoria to Pier 39. There are trolley stops along the way. If you happen to have a smart phone, go to oldoregon.com and search for "trolley tracking". This GPS tracking only shows trolley location when the trolley is running. Along the trail and working waterfront, you'll find benches to rest and enjoy the view, interpretative signage, restaurants, and shops.

**"THE BUS" Sunset Empire Transportation District**—Terminal located on Marine Dr. between 9th and 10th Streets. Open 7:30 to 6 PM Everyday. 1-866-811-1001 ridethebus.org

**RIVERFRONT TROLLEY**—The "OLD 300" travels the 4mi. riverfront and includes narration and interpretation of local history and attractions. Round trip appx. one hour. All rides after 5:30 are one way only—trolley headed to its barn. Memorial Day thru Labor Day NOON–6 FRI-SAT-SUN daily, weather permitting. Pay \$1 per boarding. Ride as long as you like —OR— pay \$2 and ride all-day long. —See page 31 for more trolley details
